SOCIAL DISTANCING

Social/physical distancing means consciously increasing the physical space between yourself and others. Social distancing along with COVID-19 vaccination, use of masks and hygiene measures can slow the spread of COVID-19.

SOCIAL DISTANCING TIPS



Keep at least 1 to 2 metres (3 to 6 feet) distance from others, even if they appear well.



Stay home when sick, even if symptoms are mild.



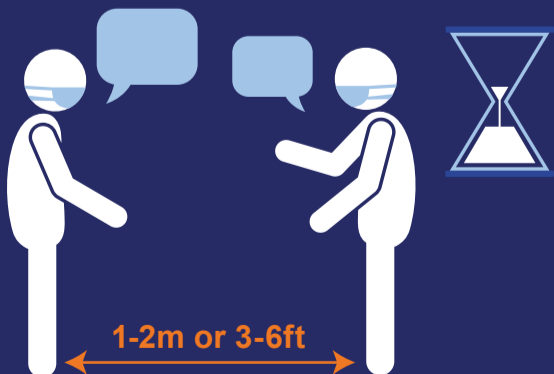
Avoid crowded places.



Stay home as much as practically possible.
Work from home.



Order essential items online or on phone.



Keep face-to-face interactions brief.



Phone your doctor for routine consultation.



Choose outdoor physical activities.



Maintain distance when greeting others.
Don't shake hands, kiss or hug.



Choose private vehicles as much as possible.
Use public transport outside of peak times.



Connect virtually with friends and family.
Minimise physical gatherings.



Choose restaurants with outdoor dining / take-away options.
